

How Does Marion Matters Work?

Marion Matters is based on a nationally known and recognized program called "Bridges Out of Poverty" which teaches that most of us grow up in a culture of poverty, middle class or wealth, and that the unspoken knowledge and rules of each culture are different. It is almost impossible to move from one class to another without having and understanding this information. For example, below are a set of differences involving financial skills:

- ⇒ In Poverty, financial skill includes knowing where all the "quick cash" places are located.
- ⇒ In Middle Class, financial skill includes knowing how to maintain a checking and savings account.
- ⇒ In Wealth, financial skill includes knowing how to manage a stocks and securities portfolio successfully.

Marion Matters engages the community and local businesses to form more effective relationships among economic classes.



In 2010, more than 1,000 Marion citizens participated in Bridges training. Marion Matters also offers "Getting Ahead In a Just Gettin' By World" classes for those in poverty who wish to achieve financial stability. Once these students graduate from the two month, twice weekly classes, they are matched with community mentors or "allies" to help them find their way through middle class systems. These students then become teachers and allies themselves for others.
